There will be security and crew members at all events. If you witness any of the above or have any concerns, please find someone and report it at the earliest opportunity. We want EVERYONE to be and feel safe.
- At the merchandise tables please treat talent with respect and do not step over their personal boundaries.
- Anyone found to be breaking any of the above will be ejected. We reserve the right to refuse entry to future shows. Keep this in mind with all interactions.
